



SCAAIDD Annual Business Meeting  
October 11, 2013  
Minutes

The annual business meeting was held on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at our annual conference held at the Crown Reef Resort in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.

**Call to Order/Verification of a Quorum:**

John called the meeting to order and verified that a quorum was present. He thanked everyone for coming and recognized the conference committee. There were approximately 275 people at the conference, including sponsors, exhibitors, and speakers.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Lois Park Mole reviewed the budget (copies were available for attendees) and said that we still have conference expenses to pay and conference revenue coming in. As of December 31, 2012 we had a balance of \$30,788.79 and our balance as of September 30, 2013 was \$35,244.54. She stated that we thought we would possibly make money on the conference this year.

**Membership Report:**

Terry reported that we have 80 members at this time which is a slight increase over this time last year. Last year we ended the year with 79 members. There are more options for membership now, including a basic membership for \$75.00 which allows you to vote, to serve as an officer, receive conference discounts, and to receive one of the journals electronically. She encouraged people to consider joining. There is a brochure in the conference packet outlining the benefits of memberships and the types of membership available.
