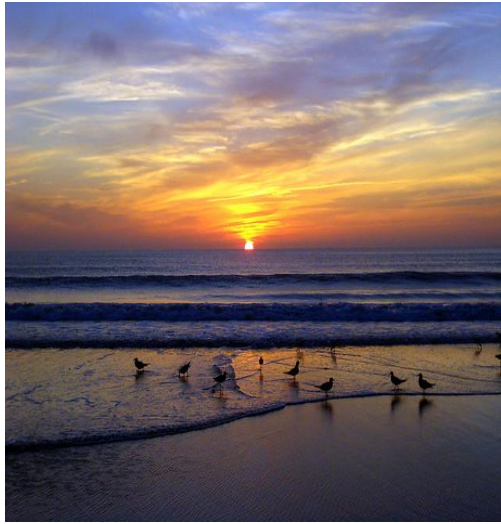

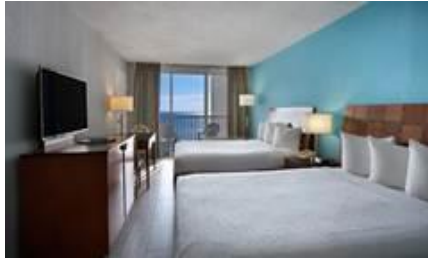

AAIDD provides several options for membership, including a new category that is much less expensive and they are as follows:

**Basic:** Basic members receive electronic access to *IDD*, and *Inclusion*, access to members-only forums, delivery of electronic newsletters, and are entitled to member discounts for meeting registration, book store purchases, and job postings.
