Minutes

Committee Assignments

Membership: There was nothing new to report.

Education: This topic has been tabled due to the large amount of training that is being currently being done within the system.

Historian/Website/Newsletter: LaDwanna Holman attended the meeting. She will be leading this committee. There was discussion of an August/September newsletter with more specific information on the conference and pictures from past conferences.

Direct Support Professional Development: Laura Cooper-Davis will have a session at the conference dedicated to Direct Support Professionals.

Conference Committee: Crystal Wright is head of the Conference Committee. Conference planning is moving ahead. One keynote has been confirmed and the prospect for another is being explored. The majority of the concurrent sessions are confirmed. Sponsor and exhibitor sales are ahead of this time last year and should exceed last year's amount.

Legislative News: Lois Park Mole informed the committee of the current status of the DDSN budget. The budget has been sent to the Governor for vetoes. DDSN expects the budget to be favorable. DDSN should issue a budget update soon.

New Business

There was no new business to come before the committee.

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Old Business

Nikki Bramlett informed the committee that she received notice from the Secretary of State that they had received and accepted the registration and therefore SCAAIDD was in compliance with the registration requirement of the “South Carolina Solicitation of Charitable Funds Act”.
